2/2 Presentation of the Lord – Candlemas
The origins of the feast lie in ancient Jewish custom. On the 40th day after childbirth, parents brought their infant baby boy to the Temple to present him to the God and to purify the mother.

The true significance of our feast concerns Jesus coming to the Temple, accentuating the Jewish faith of Jesus and the dignity of all human life from infants to the elderly in the person of Simeon and Anna. Jesus is the Promised One, whose light will shine, beaming rays of hope to all the world. It is on this day, that we bless the candles that we use for religious purposes during the year.

2/3 St. Blaise – “Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness.” These are the words of the special blessing of the throats customarily given on this day.

2/17 Ash Wednesday is the beginning of Lent, a penitential season. A cross is marked with ash on the forehead of each member of the congregation. The ashes come from the palm leaves of the previous year’s Palm Sunday service. Ashes remind us that we all will face death and our bodies will return to the earth. The cross affirms our redemption and eternal salvation through Jesus Christ.

5/23 Pentecost – Pentecost is the day on which Jesus Christ’s disciples received the gift of the Holy Spirit, which empowered them to proclaim the good news. Pentecost is often referred to as the day the Church was born.

5/30 Trinity Sunday – is celebrated a week after Pentecost Sunday in honor of the Holy Trinity.
